SECURITY LIGHTING SERVICE AGREEMENT

The Cooperative will install, own and maintain security lighting facilities for the consumer provided the installation is made on an existing wood pole where the appropriate secondary voltage is available. The consumer must sign the required Security Lighting service agreement agreeing to a contract term of not less than one year at the applicable rate schedule, and pay a contribution-in aid of construction of sixty dollars (\$60.00). Should the security light be installed at the time of initial line construction, the cooperative may waive the \$60.00 contribution-in-aid of construction cost.

In the event the consumer desires the security light to be installed at a location where there is no existing wood pole with the appropriate secondary available, a contribution-in-aid of construction shall be assessed for the full cost of the additional facilities.

Security lighting may not be available to consumers at locations where persistent damage to the security light occurs.

Disconnected Security lights of a period of 90 days or more may be subject to retirement (removal), and future installations will require payment of a contribution in aid of construction charge.
